



Kitsap Rescue Mission Shelter

We will provide 75 safe, secure shelter beds paired with supportive on-site services in South Kitsap County. The shelter will be a closed site in a dorm-like setting and will be closed to the public. There will be no walk-up services and guests will be referred from the KCR Housing Solutions Center.

The Kitsap Rescue Mission program goal is to provide opportunities for guests to find permanent housing and wellness and to successfully transition into self-sufficiency.

Using a trauma informed approach, KRM will be professionally staffed, with on-site security twenty-four hours a day, seven days per week, and will provide safety for our guests, our staff, the facility and surrounding property.

Guest Services at Kitsap Rescue Mission Will Include:

A professional support team including Service Coordinators and Behavioral Health Navigators who will triage guests upon intake and co-create a Housing Stability Plan.

One-on-one support and counseling will occur using a Progressive Engagement approach to:

- Assist in accessing needed community services such as mental health and substance use disorder treatment
- Support re-engagement into wellness and employment development opportunities
- Build life-skills that assist in the progression toward self-sufficiency
- Offer spiritual support and Chapel opportunities when requested
- Provide access to meals and laundry services
